YWCA Enid offers a wide range of roles and activities for anyone willing to give their time, talent and energy to make a difference in the Enid community.

From retired individuals, students and all ages of civic organizations to the individual that has a little extra time and heart for service, YWCA Enid offers numerous opportunities to make a difference and get involved.

## WAYS YOU CAN HELP

### **Office & Maintenance**

Assist with general office duties, brochures preparation, basic database entry, organize supply rooms, cleaning, flower bed and playground maintenance.

### **Sister's Closet**

Assist with sorting and organizing donations.

### **Crisis Center & Halfway House**

Organize storage closets, help clean and prepare rooms for clients, plan special events (i.e. birthday parties, field trips, life skills classes).



Attend additional training to provide direct client services which can include extensive contact with clients through Crisis Line coverage, client advocacy or becoming a Sexual Assault Response Advocate (SARA).



### **Special Projects**

Groups or individuals can complete a special project that you or YWCA Enid chooses.

Examples of past projects include: Coordinating a fundraiser or donation drive, painting projects, grounds clean-up, spring cleaning, building projects and organizing or "adopting a room" to makeover and re-furnish.

### **Special Events**

Distribute posters and fliers, assist staff with event preparation and clean-up.

### **Internships**

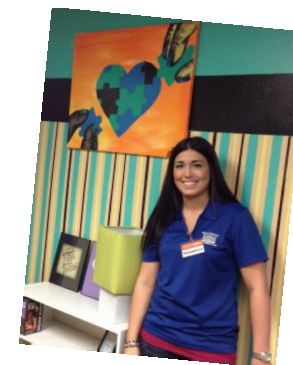
There are many different internship opportunities with YWCA Enid. Contact the Volunteer Coordinator for more information.
