OUR PROGRAMS:

WHEN YOU SUPPORT YWCA ENID, YOU ARE HELPING TO MAINTAIN AND IMPROVE THESE PROGRAMS.

CRISIS CENTER

YWCA Enid Crisis Center provides a safe haven for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking. Services include free group or individual counseling, court and victim advocacy, and a safe clean room with access to food, clothing, and personal care items. Life skills training and parenting support is also offered. A 24 hour Crisis Line is also available with Spanish and English speaking victim advocates to offer crisis intervention, safety planning, assistance with protective orders, educational materials and many more helpful resources. All calls are confidential.

YOUTH PROGRAMS

YWCA Enid offers several annual events to meet the needs of the youth in our community. Girl Power is an annual event that empowers girls grades 5th - 9th by discussing current social issues such as bullying, self-confidence, beauty, and social media. YWCA Teen Christmas Sponsorship offers Christmas gifts to teens in the community who normally would go without through private donations and a partnership with Autry Technology Center. YWCA Enid Racial Justice program provides educational materials to local youth on current social issues dealing with race.

SANE PROGRAM

YWCA Enid has an on-site room for a specially trained SANE Nurse to complete exams on victims of rape and sexual assault. SANE stands for Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner. The room is designed to help comfort the victim as much as possible in the circumstances as opposed to a normal exam room. A SARA (Sexual Assault Response Advocate) is also provided and accompanies rape victims in their time of need. New clothing, medication, and counseling are also options provided to victims who come to the SANE room. This service is available anytime day or night. 580.234.7581

MY SISTER'S CLOSET

Individuals in need can find clothing and household items at this on-site facility for free. The donated items from the community allow many women and children to get back on their feet when they arrive with nothing or when it is time for them to leave and start a new life. We also serve the community at large, including men. My Sister's Closet is opened Monday-Friday from 10:00am - 4:00pm.

YWCA Enid. Building Hope. Building Lives.

Women come to us in times of crisis, as survivors of rape or domestic violence. We work to help them become independent by providing support and counseling. They leave more confident with a renewed spirit, new skills, and stronger lives.

Across the globe, YWCA has more than 25 million members in 122 countries, including 2 million members in 300 local associations in the United States.

More important than the numbers is our mission to eliminate racism and empower women. We provide safe places for women and girls, build strong women leaders, and advocate for women's rights and civil rights.

CRISIS CENTER SERVICES

Received 532 calls on the crisis line

Provided 179 victims with safe emergency shelter for a total of 2,881 days

Assisted with 91 protective order filings

227 Lethality Assessments were received from the Enid Police Department

COUNSELING

122 clients received 1,398 hours of counseling services after experiencing a traumatic life event

39 clients participated in group counseling or classes

YOUTH OUTREACH

Annual Girl Power Rally had 27 girls in attendance between the ages 5th-9th grade

Project Cinderella provided prom dresses and accessories to over 136 individuals

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

YWCA Staff provided 27 Presentations on Domestic Violence & Sexual Assault education & prevention, Suicide, Bullying, Body image, Self-esteem, and Parenting to 885 individuals

YWCA Staff provided 8 booths at community events

SANE PROGRAM

Provided 35 Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Exams

Provided 5 Domestic Violence Injury Exams

SANE Coordinator provided over 301 hours of service

3,669 men, women, and children from 1,188 households received FREE clothing and household items from My Sister's Closet

Teen Christmas provided gifts for 156 teens

20 families with 81 individuals were sponsored for the Adopt-a-Family Christmas program

369 Volunteers provided over 1903 hours of service for a savings of \$13,797 in paid wages
